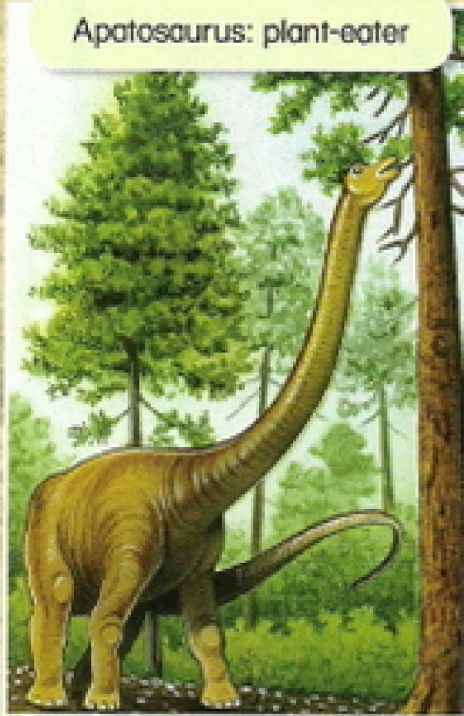
## DINOSAURS

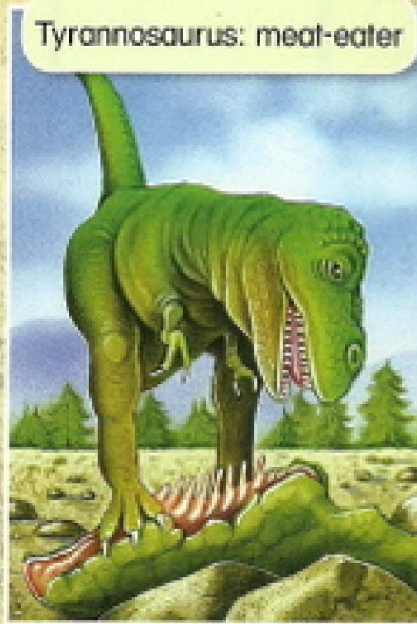
Scientists studied dinosaur teeth. The scientists learned many things. For example, many dinosaurs ate plants. Some dinosaurs ate meat.

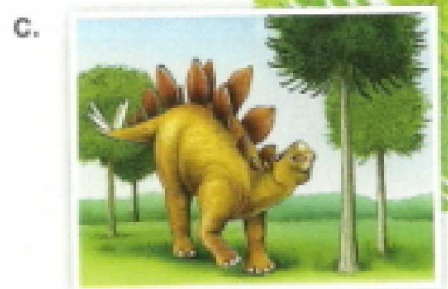
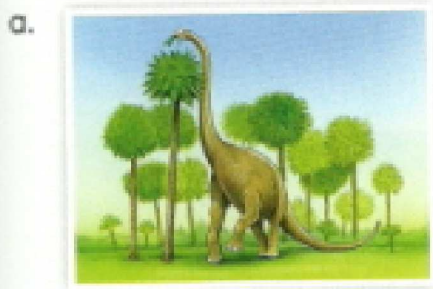

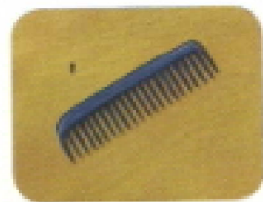
